

ANCHORAGE SCHOOL DISTRICT Gift Receipt General Guidelines and Safe Harbors AMC 1.15.025 Effective July 1, 2014

The following guidelines are intended to simplify gift standards and eliminate disclosure requirements for certain items, including small gifts, homemade gifts, gifts for immediate consumption or display expressing general appreciation or holiday cheer, and discounts and prizes generally available to public sector employees or to large groups or employees.

An item is a "gift" if it is: of value provided to a **oripati**/ASD employee, including but not limited to money, cash **exts**, ivale services, discounts, meals, and entertainment.

Prior approval must be received from the Municipal Ethics basiare using a gift that does not fall within the gift gueislelin stated below.

NOTE: Gifts valued over \$50.00 are rarely approved.

Under AMC 1.15.025, General Ruheunicipal/ASD employee may not:

Accept a gift from an individual or an entity with interests that may be substantially affected by the performance of the person's official municipal/ASD duties under circumstances where the timing and nature of the gift would cause a reasonable person to question the person's judgment in exercising official municipal duties.

Safe Harbors: Unless other factofrisnfluence are present, an employee may accept the following items:

- x An item given to an ASD employee for a special occasion given voluntarily by ASD coworkers.
- X A perishable item given for immediate consumption or display, from members of the public or classroom expressing general appreciation or holiday cheer, shared with an office, work group, or classroom.
- X A discount, prize, or award available to public sector employees generally, or to a large business category of public employees to which the municipal/ASD employee belongs.
- x A monetary award or item presented to a municipal/ASD employee in recognition of meritorious, civic, or voluntary service presented by a recognized civic, philanthropic or non-profit charitable organization.
- x An item, homemade or handmade, made by the giver.
- x An occasional small gift worth \$50 or less, including business meals.
